



IZettle Payment links

- Download the Zettle Go app
- Activate the Payment Links feature in Settings
- Add products to your basket and select “Send Link” when you checkout
- Fill in your customer’s name, a few words or a reference number (to keep track of your sent links).
- Choose how to send the link: SMS, email or any messaging app installed on your device (Facebook Messenger, WhatsApp, etc.).
- Send the link and wait for your customer to pay!

All you have to do is create a SumUp profile and you're ready to get started. To send a payment link, create a checkout in the SumUp App, select Payment Links as the payment method and then share the link with your customer.

- On your [SumUp profile](#), click "Payment Links" on the left-hand menu.
- Select "Create Payment Link".
- Add a payment amount and a description then click "Create link".
- Copy the link and share it via your preferred channel.



Square Payment links

- From your Virtual Terminal, select Virtual Terminal > Take a Payment.
- Add the items and the customer.
- From the Payment Method section of Payment Details, select Send Payment Link.
- Select your customer's country code.
- Enter the customer's phone number and click Send Link.
